

The Quinte Children's Treatment Centre is partnering with Quinte Health Care to host vaccination clinics specifically for clients of the centre. This includes any child that receives services through any one of our programs. Feel free to register siblings in the age range as well. The purpose of this is to provide a more supportive environment for those that may have struggles in the more public COVID-19 vaccine clinics. Details are provided below.

For those of you that received your first vaccine through our clinics in Dec, you should have already received an email to set up an appointment for your child(s) second dose. If you haven't and they still require their second dose, you can register through the link below.

The following clinics are available for first or second vaccines. Make sure to indicate on the registration form in the area provided the date of your child's first vaccine. Second doses can be provided 8 weeks from the first dose.

**Dates: January 27, 2022      1 pm to 5:30**  
**February 10, 2022      1 pm to 5:30**

**Location: Education Centre at Quinte Health Care. The education centre is in the WCA wing of Belleville Hospital. Parking is on the corner of Dufferin Avenue and Dundas Street East on the left as you go down Dufferin toward the Emergency Dept. The parking lot is on the left side in front of the WCA building. Bring your parking ticket with you to the appointment and it will be validated for free parking. Enter the WCA wing from the parking lot and staff will be there to direct you to the Education Centre.**
